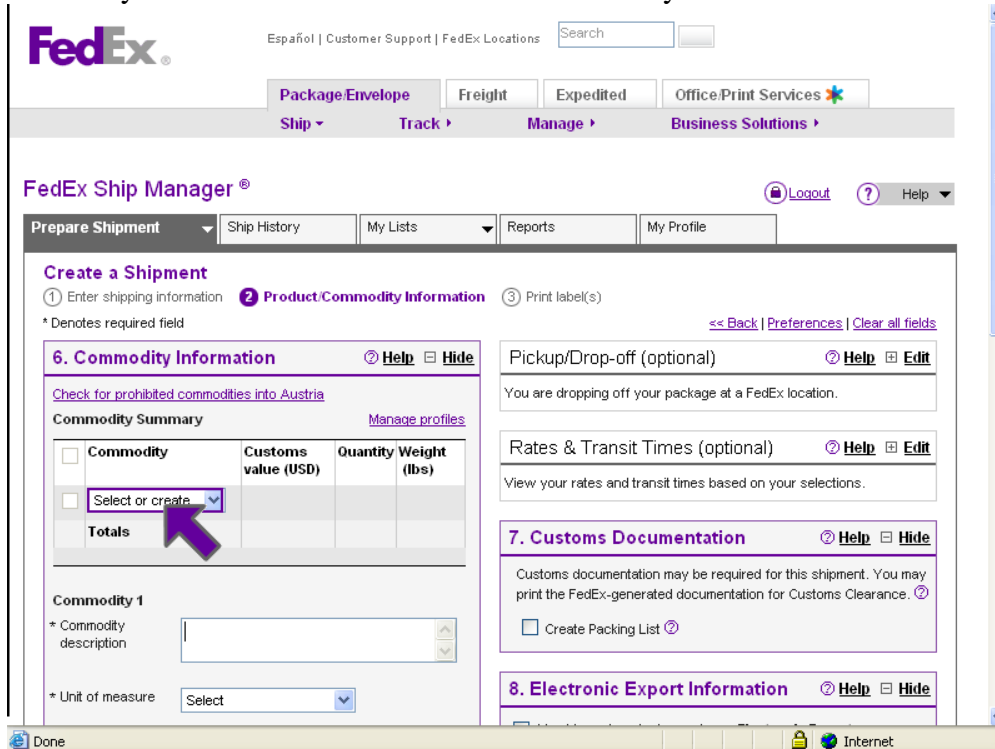


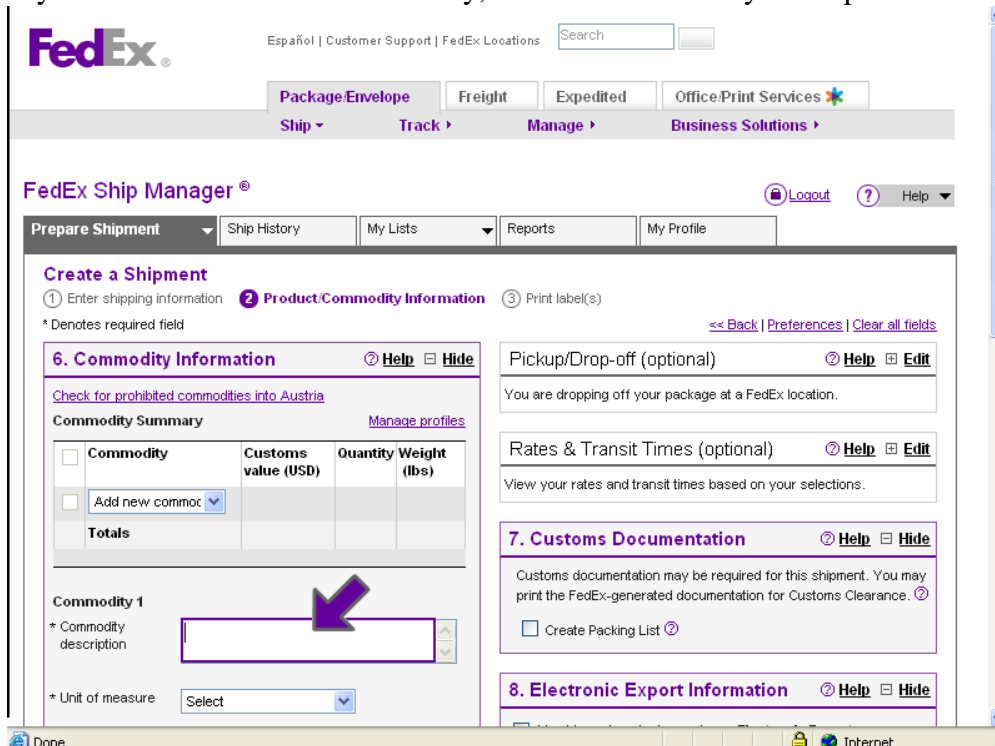
# Entering Commodities when Shipping Internationally on fedex.com

## ➤ Step by Step

1. Select if you want to select or add a new commodity.



2. If you want to add a new commodity, enter the commodity description.



3. Select the unit of measure.
